


WHAT IS AN **ENLARGED PROSTATE?**

Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia (BPH), also known as an enlarged prostate, is a progressive condition affecting many men as they get older.

As the prostate enlarges, it presses on and blocks the urethra, which may cause bothersome urinary symptoms such as:

- Frequent need to urinate both day and night
- Urgent feeling of needing to urinate
- Weak or slow urinary stream





WHAT HAPPENS IF BPH IS NOT TREATED?

If left untreated, BPH can lead to permanent bladder damage³ and in some cases may cause the inability to urinate, which requires the use of a catheter.²



The UroLift System is a minimally invasive treatment option that can help men get off BPH medications and avoid major surgery, while preserving sexual function.*5

- Only leading enlarged prostate procedure that does not require heating, cutting, removal, or destruction of prostate tissue⁶⁻⁸
- Can be performed as a same-day outpatient procedure in the office setting under local anesthesia⁹ – and patients typically return home without a catheter^{6,9}
- Covered by most private insurers and Medicare (*when medical criteria are met*)

- Rapid symptom relief – in as early as 2 weeks⁶ – and better relief than reported with medications^{6,7}
- Rapid recovery in days, not months⁹ – lowest catheter rate of the leading BPH procedures^{5,9-13}
- Risk profile better than reported for surgical procedures such as TURP^{6-7,14}
- Only leading BPH procedure shown to not cause new and lasting sexual dysfunction^{*7-8,15}

STEP 1

The UroLift® Delivery Device is placed through the obstructed urethra to access the enlarged prostate.




STEP 2

Small implants are permanently placed to lift and hold the enlarged prostate tissue out of the way and increase the opening of the urethra.



STEP 3

The UroLift System procedure provides symptom relief by opening the obstructed urethra.
